Use a coin or a key to do a scratch test, to check if all the protective coating has been removed.

When white abrasion occurs, carry out a full clean to remove all the protective coating













The cleaning and care instructions are recommendations and suggestions and apply to floorings in object quality.



**Polyofine floor coverings are scratch-sensitive floor coverings. Do not use abrasive pads or brushes.**  
**Polyofine floor coverings are sensitive to certain solvents, such as ketone, ester and chlorinated hydrocarbon.**  
Fat-soluble colorants such as shoe polish or asphalt can penetrate into polyofine floor coverings: diffusion  
Polyofine floor coverings are sensitive to cigarette burns, glowing cigarettes and deposit marks.  
Polyofine floor coverings are very resistant to strong alkalines and acids.

Polyofine is an elastic, synthetic, chlorine-free covering made from polyethylene and polypropylene, fillers and colour pigments.  
Polyofine has good electrical insulation properties and often strong electrostatic charges.  
Homogeneous polyofine floor coverings consist of one or more layers with the same composition.  
Heterogeneous polyofine floor coverings consist of several layers with the same basic materials but with a different composition.

Distinguishing feature: fire assay with a glowing hot needle in an inconspicuous place: no acrid smell, crater cannot be removed with the fingers.



Remove loose dirt before every cleaning, damp mop smooth floors and vacuum structured floors.  
Cleaning agents and surface treatments may alter the appearance and properties of a floor's surface.  
Test on an inconspicuous spot to find which product is suitable for your requirements.  
Test beforehand on an inconspicuous spot to see if the cleaning agent or surface treatment damages the floor.  
Dirt-trapping zones, incl. dirt-trapping mats (Wetrok Gardamat) in the entrance, at least 7m long, greatly reduce the amount of dirt tracked into the building.
